What we do here at Garden House

- We provide specialist palliative care for patients, their families and carers facing life-limiting illnesses, enabling them to have the best possible quality of life by providing care and support in the setting of their choice
- We support thousands of people living in North Hertfordshire, Stevenage and surrounding towns and villages in Central Bedfordshire and Cambridgeshire every year
- At Garden House Hospice we have an Inpatient Unit, Emotional & Psychological Support Service, a Hospice at Home team, we provide Care Home support and run a Frailty Service.

What your support can help us with

- **£14** could pay for a freshly cooked meal for a patient on our Inpatient Unit
- **£22** could provide an hour of care on our Inpatient Unit, for one patient
- **£75** could fund an activity from our Rehab & Wellbeing team, such as a physiotherapy appointment or Strength & Balance class
- **£102** could pay for the travel costs for the community team for one day
- **£408** could cover the weekly cost of buying, repairing and replacing our equipment, including hoists, medical equipment and plumbing systems.
